FAQs About the Transition

Q. Will there be any disruption in my vehicle donation services?

No. Vehicle donation processing and donor support for your program will continue uninterrupted. However, without a signed agreement in place with CARS, we will be unable to provide you with the full benefits of our program.

Q. Why is there a new agreement?

CARS is also a 501(c)(3) nonprofit and follows all fundraising and government compliance to process donations for nonprofits in every state. In order for us to provide full service for your vehicle donation program, we must have a signed and current Terms of Service Agreement on file.

Q. How does this affect my revenue?

Our blended networks enhance our ability to sell your donated vehicles for a higher price for top-end, mid-tier, and low-end units. If you would also like direct-deposit payments of your revenue, please download and complete the <u>Automatic Deposit Form (ACH)</u> and submit a copy to Beth Carter, Support Manager Market Development, at <u>bethc@careasy.org</u>, or to our Partner Success team at <u>carspartners@careasy.org</u>.

Q. What access to reporting will I have?

CARS is collaborating with IAA to ensure a seamless transition of your program. CARS will provide the same information that is being provided today from IAA plus online, real-time donation tracking in NAV (CARS donation database). You'll be able to follow your donations from start to finish with full transparency in revenue and donor information.

Your team will receive NAV login credentials to securely access all of your donation data and easy-to-use reporting tools with popular and customized reporting options, interactive graphs, print-formatted exports, time-frame sorting and more.

Q. Can I still get access to my old data?

Yes, additional access to historical information will be provided.

Q. What will happen to my current vehicle donation page?

CARS and IAA are working together to ensure there is no loss of service for your program. Your existing donation pages, forms, and phone numbers will be directed to and maintained by CARS. Please contact us if you'd like to make updates to your pages.
